ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In addition to a completed application, an applicant must provide the following to be admitted to degree candidacy:

- Official transcripts showing completion of a bachelor's degree in an appropriate content area from an accredited university or college and an overall grade point average of 3.00. Thirty credits must be completed within the content area in which the applicant intends to teach.
- Official copies of passing Praxis II scores (Delaware) in the applicant's content area.
- Resume and statement of philosophy of teaching and learning.
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be an evaluation of the applicant's instructional ability and attitude toward the teaching/learning process. Applicants who lack teaching experience should ask for a recommendation from a college instructor in their major discipline or an employer familiar with their teaching potential.
