I. Accept Previous Meeting Minutes

a. Debra Sharrow moved to accept the previous meeting minutes, seconded by Susan Jones. Motion carried 4-0.

II. Monthly Variance Report (as of October 31, 2023)

- a. The fiscal year is 33.33% completed
- b. Revenue:
 - i. State: Balances are still mostly just the preloads.
 - ii. Local:
 - 1. Received bulk of tax receipts in October
 - 2. Currently at 73%
 - iii. Federal: Still waiting on grants to hit the report, they were received in November
- c. Expenditures:
 - i. School budget are a bit overspent overall for the time of the year; they will receive a small bump in the final budget.
 - ii. Marketing / Public Communication: Reviewing expenditures with the department.
 - iii. Overall budget at 28.59%
- d. ESSER II
 - i. Funds were fully spent by 11/30/2023, will be reflected in the November report.
- e. ESSER III
 - i. Some amendments will need to be made for any allocations that were spent out at greater than 110%
- f. Debra Sharrow moved to recommend approval of this report, seconded by Tanya Kerns. Motion carried 4-0.

III. Referendum Presentation

- a. Capital Request:
 - i. Total of \$120MM:
 - 1. State 60% (\$73.2MM)
 - 2. Local 40% (\$48.8MM)
 - ii. If referendum fails, we will have up to one year from Certificate of Necessity (Nov 2024) to pass; limited to two votes.
 - iii. Colonial buildings average 60 years old.
 - iv. Funds to be used for the following projects:
 - 1. Complete roofing projects
 - 2. Improve parking lots and pathways
 - 3. Revive middle school athletic fields
 - 4. Replace older elementary school playgrounds
 - 5. New William Penn HS athletic fields and facilities
 - 6. Add secure entrance vestibules and other security enhancements

- v. Estimated tax rate maximum 16.9¢ in FY2027
- vi. Estimated maximum tax rate for **new** projects: 12.2¢ in FY2029
- b. Operating Request:
 - The last operating referendum was supposed to be for just 4 years, but was stretched to 7 years.
 This was aided by temporary lower expenses in 2020 due to the pandemic and the ESSER funding.
 - ii. In FY2023, the district had \$5.3MM in deficit spending; project that to be \$7.7MM in FY2024.
 - iii. Total ask is for 40¢ per \$100 of assessed value.
 - iv. Can be phased in over 2-3 years:
 - 1. Option #1: 40¢ in FY2025
 - 2. Option #2: 25¢ in FY2025; 15¢ in FY2026
 - 3. Option #3: 25¢ in FY2025; 10¢ in FY2026; 5¢ in FY2027
 - v. Average Assessed Value: \$62,547
 - vi. Average impact per household: ~\$250
