## HOW TO APPLY FOR THE EARLY COLLEGE PROGRAM

#### Step One – Review and Contact WP staff

Review available course offerings. Discuss opportunities with parents and get approval from your school counselor. Students must be a Junior or Senior, and have a GPA of 2.7 or higher. If all parties agree that this is a good choice, contact site coordinator: Mr. Kevin Wright in the Innovation Center. His email address is <u>kevin.wright@colonial.k12.de.us</u>. He can answer any questions and assist in the registration process. Mr. Wright will conduct a registration workshop in the Innovation Center on Thursday, January 4, 2018 (2:30 – 4:00 PM)

#### Step Two – Register at Wilmington University

First, contact Lisa Lombardozzi (<u>lisa.c.lombardozzi@wilmu.edu</u>), and then complete the registration process at <u>https://recruitfe.erp.wilmu.edu/Admissions/Pages/Welcome.aspx</u>. Mr. Wright will conduct a registration workshop in the Innovation Center on Thursday, January 4, 2018 (2:30 – 4:00 PM)

#### Step Three – Create a Wilmington University Account

Create a "MyWilmU" account. They will ask a series of questions: Entry Term – Spring 2018; Academic Level – Undergraduate; Academic Programs – Early College – non degree; Highest level of education – current high school student

#### Step Four – Submit an Application for the Early College Program

Select the last tab 'Early College/Dual Application'. Complete the 'Personal Information' section. If you do not have a Social Security # or VISA #, please contact <u>lisa.c.lombardozzi@wilmu.edu</u> or 302.378.0356.

In the 'Academic Plans' Section, please enter ~ **Early College** ~ <u>If you select any other option, you will be</u> <u>charged full tuition for this course</u>. Our "Early College Program" is offered at a reduced rate for WPENN students. William Penn students/parents are responsible to cover all fees. Cost per course is \$125 plus registration fee and materials fees.

Complete the Signature Section. The FERPA/Parent Contract/High School Transcript, and SAT scores for MAT/ENG need to be uploaded to your new account.

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#### Step Five – Classes begin January 16, 2017
