

## **Traditional Learning**

**Fixed** Mindset of Learning

Focus On Grades

Learning Behaviors (personal responsibility, work ethic, collboration, civic responsibility) **Included in Subject Grade** 

**Single** Measure Used to Determine Progress

**Growth** Mindset of Learning

Focus On **Learning** 

Learning Behaviors **Reported Separately** as "Approaches to Learning"

**Multiple** Measures Used to Determine Progress


# **How is Student Progress Tracked?**



Teachers align student assignments to content standards.



Teachers assess students mastery of standards.



Teachers determine student proficiency on the standards.
