

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING and WRITTEN INPUT PROCESS

The Colonial Board of Education will hold a public meeting for the purpose of considering a waiver of the provisions of the following two sections of Title 14 of the *Delaware Code* (14 <u>Del.C.</u>, §§1704 and 1705A) for all district schools.

- 1. 14 <u>Del.C.</u>, §1704 requires the assignment of 98 percent of Division I teaching units generated by actual student enrollment on the last school day in October be assigned to the school generating the teaching units.
- 2. 14 <u>Del.C.</u>, §1705A restricts the number of students assigned to core academic subjects (English/language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies) in grades kindergarten through three (K-3) to a teacher/student ratio of one to 22 (1:22) on the last school day in October.

The Board may waive these provisions following public notice, public input, and a Board meeting.

A public meeting of the Colonial Board of Education will be held on November 09, 2021 for the purpose of considering the matter of a waiver for each of the above provisions and other regular business of the Board.
