- b. Revenue:
 - i. Nothing to report on State Revenue
 - ii. Local revenue looks good Emily continues to monitor
 - iii. E3+ closing early due to lack of funding
 - iv. Emily will check on Federal Revenue on Title I
 - v. Otherwise, nothing going on with Revenue overall.
- c. School Budgets: Running Light, might be trying to carry over into next year.
- d. Discretionary Budgets:
 - i. Copy Center High: Emily will investigate
 - ii. Overall, department budgets are under projected
 - iii. Discussion: Does District have a plan in place for hiring teachers. Basically, there are not enough teachers coming out of the University. The District and State are looking for other alternatives but this is a National Problem.
- e. Restricted Budgets: Good
 - i. State Security- Over incumbered but it might be waiting for money from another source.
 - ii. Tuition Budget- Special Education hit hard- no staff so contracting out for these. State money coming in for options. Not going to cause problems.
- f. Leach: Under Budget
- g. General District: On Target
- h. Nutrition Budget: Only problem is items unavailable when ordering daily. Told to be Conservative. Good at substitutions when needed. But volatile to the availability of food items.
- i. Transportation: Contractors, Homeless, and Foster Care runs are out of alignment with budget. Will probably be over budget in this line

- j. Construction Funds: Beginning to move. Bid out last week for a Construction Manager for the new Leach School
- k. Tax Receipts for March: Lower than previous years except for last year. But nothing to worry about.
- I. E3 Grant: State tells Colonial to continue spending the funds. Delaware has joined the National Lawsuit of Federal Government
