I. Accept Previous Meeting Minutes

Tanya Kerns moves to accept previous meeting minutes, seconded by Debra Sharrow. Motion carried 5-0.

II. Monthly Budget Variance Report (as of May 2025)

- 1. Fiscal year is 92% completed
- 2. Revenue State 99% Over budget on interest and Direct Cost. Will be reconciled by end of the year.
- 3. Federal Revenue: 93% No real concerns
- 4. Expenses: Overall is low. Centralizing expenses for some things helps with the Building expenses...like nurse's medical supplies
- 5. Division Budgets: Highs and Lows but over-all below trend
- 6. Salary Budget: Coding has been corrected. No problems evident.
- 7. Discipline Programs: Need increased funding
- 8. Copy Center: Some cost coming from Leach and Colwyck
- 9. Child Wellness: The services from this year may be billed to District next year, but an open PO will be used to pay for this year's services. 2026 will be year 3 of a 3 year commitment to Nemours for this program.
- 10. Middle School Athletics: Some discussion on how this line should be labeled in the budget.

III. Restricted Budgets:

- 1. Technology expenses have been recoded
- 2. Transportation overages line up with the number of routes or other expenses needed for demand for drivers

IV Other Restricted Budget:

- 1. Opportunity Budget not being spent out.
- 2. Other State Revenue: receiving more from State, allowing us to spend more
- 3. Special Education needed other services and contracts to stay in compliance with student IEP's.
- 4. Child Nutrition: On budget
- **5.** General Expenses: Nothing to report
- 6. Transportation: Overall high this year. Looking for coding changes and formula changes
- 7. Leach: Under Budget overall. Move more to Consolidated Budget next year.
- 8. Construction Funds: Movement in William Penn Line. Other schools will be starting by the 2026 school year.
- 9. No Private Grants so far this year
- 10. ESSER done and spent out waiting for money from the state to completely close out
